Following are the details of the event:-


Name of the Event	:	Regional Level Tribal Meet for Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Rangers of Western Region and Central Region.

Venue	:	Farmer Training Centre, Dokmardi, Besides Dr. APJ ABDUL Kalam Govt. Collage, Silvasa, Dadar and Nagar Haveli.
Date of Arrival	:	25 th June, 2019 Before Lunch.
Date of Departure	:	29 th June, 2019 After Lunch.
How to Reach	:	The nearest Railway Station is VAPI, 20 KM distance from Silvasa. The shearing Auto are available from Vapi (East) to Pipariya out post. Who can attend	:	Tribal Scouts / Guides / Rovers / Rangers of registered Units completed Tiritiya Sopan in Scout/ Guide or Nipun in Rover / Ranger are eligible to participate in the Meet. Where there are no Tribal Scouts / Guides/ Rovers/ Rangers units. In such a case Scouts / Guides / Rovers / Rangers from rural area may be deputed.
Fee	:	Scout Guide Welfare Fund: Rs. 180/- per head for Scouts, Guides, Rovers & Rangers and Rs. 280/- per head for Unit Leaders to be paid at the time of registration.
Quota	:	Tribal Scouts : - 06 Rovers : - 04 Adult Leader : - 02 Tribal Guides : - 06 Rangers : - 04 Total : - 22. (No additional participants will be accepted).

Financial Assistance	<p>Concessional 2nd Sleeper Class Railway fare, Ordinary Govt. Bus fare will be reimburse on production of Train Tickets & Bus Tickets in Original. National Headquarters will reimburse travel subsidy maximum @ Rs.550/- per head or actual whichever is less, on production of train / bus tickets.</p> <p>No AC/Volvo fare will be paid (Auto/taxi fare or Tatkal fare is not admissible).</p> <p>Participants from Railway States should ensure utilization of Railway Pass. Free lodging and boarding will be provided during the camp days.</p>
What to Bring	<p>INDIVIDUAL KIT:- Two sets of Correct and complete uniforms as per APRO II/III, Toilet requisites, Personal dress, Warm Clothing, Note Book, Pen, Knotting Rope, Sutli, Knife, Personal First Aid Kit, Plate, Glass, Spoon, Torch, Chart Paper, Writing Materials, Warm Bedding, Traditional Costumes for Cultural Programmes, required materials for Traditional village Fair / Exhibition, Tribal Food Plaza, Festivals and Rangoli etc.</p> <p>PATROL KIT:- Patrol Utensils such as Bucket, Jug, Patila, Bucket, Donga, Tasla, Serving Spoon, Kettle, Mug, eating utensils, etc. for receiving meals from the Central Mess. Ground Sheet, Gadget items Musical Instrument, Local Costumes for festival and Village fair. Food ingredients for food Plaza etc.</p>
