

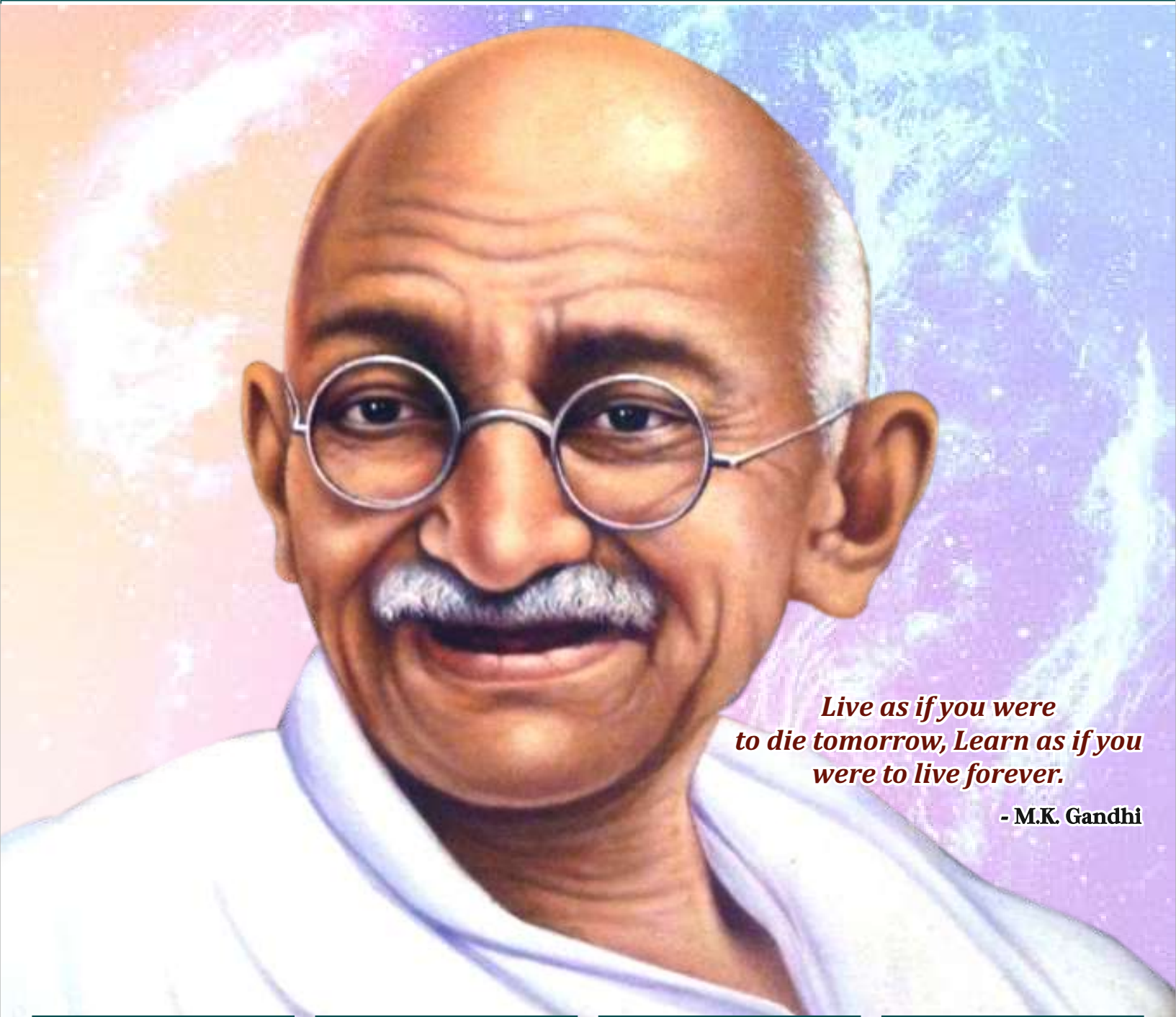

In the current COVID -19 crisis, the members of the state involved in educating the masses of uneducated villagers on the do's & don't's to overcome Corona Virus, explaining the basics of health & hygiene, hand washing, sanitizers etc. maintaining Social distancing and personal distancing, providing basic raw materials like rice, pulses, flour, biscuits etc in packets and distribution of Cooked food with all precautions to the needy, in Porter kholi slum area, Balasai, Tanti basti, Aam Bagan area, and Slum areas of Railway colonies. Cloth masks were distributed to the villagers. Thermal tests were conducted under the guidance of Railway Hospital authorities. As per the directives of Ayush Mantralaya, Ayurvedic Kadha was also prepared to boost up the immunity of Railway Staff and other people and it was distributed twice a week.





Trainer's Corner

SCOUTING SUNRISE

It was in May 1907 while on holiday in Ireland, the Founder Baden-Powell met Mr. and Mrs. Charles Van Raalte and they became friends. They invited him to visit their country home on 500-acre Brownsea Island. As a boy Baden Powell was already familiar with Brownsea Island when he sailed in Poole Harbour with his brother. So, B. P. visited the island and chose it for the camp because it will be "... away from outsiders, press reporters and other 'vermin', where I could try out the experiment without interruption."

It is to be recollected that Robert Stephenson Smith Baden Powell had become a national hero during the Boer war as a result of his successful defence of Mafeking which was under Siege from October 1899 to May 1900. The Mafeking cadets made up of local boys aged 12 to 15 acted as messengers throughout the siege and had impressed him with their resourcefulness and courage. After the war B.P. discussed the idea of forming a new youth organisation with William Alexander Smith, founder of Boy's Brigade and he also travelled across British to gather ideas from different people to form a new youth organization. To test his ideas while writing Scouting for Boys, he conceived an experimental camp.



Having decided, he wrote a letter to Mr Charles Van Raalte asking for permission to use the island. He responded immediately. To help with plans, Raalte enclosed a booklet about the island and its history which he had recently published. B.P. selected a little piece of ground, a mile and a half long and about three quarters of a mile wide. Baden-Powell invited some of his army friends to send their sons, but right from the start he was clear that Scouting was to be for all boys, not just for a privileged minority.

Boys from different social backgrounds were invited as participants. The camp was initially planned from 1 to 8 August 1907. But the camp was held for nine days. Ten of 'town boys' were from Boy's Brigade companies, seven from Bournemouth and three from Poole; and Eleven, mostly sons of Baden Powell's friends from private public schools. His nine-year old nephew Donald Baden Powell also attended. These participants were not Scouts in the true sense of the word - they had not taken the Law and the Promise.

A camp fee was charged from all the participants to organize the camp though he could get the entire camp

expenses through donations. So it is clear that Scouting is not free. At the end of the camp, he published the camp finances, according to which he collected hardly 15 pounds towards messing charges for 21 boys for 8 days. It shows that the camp was organized economically.

Captain Henry Robson of the Bournemouth Company supplied Bell tents on hire with flooring for sleeping along with other items like a flag pole. Captain G.W. Green of Poole Boy's Brigade was involved in catering.

B-P wrote letters of invitation to all the parents and promised " ... wholesome food, cooking and sanitation, etc. would be carefully looked into ... ". He advised them that the boys should be practised in three knots - reef, sheet bend and clove hitch - before arrival and they must be able to swim.

The camp was planned for nine days starting from Monday 1 August, 1907 and both Baden Powell and McLaren arrived well in advance preparing for the boy's arrival.

Baden Powell, his nephew and some of the boys sailed two miles by a boat Hyacinth from London to Brownsea Island on 29th. B.P. and the boys made their way half mile along the island shore to the Campsite. B-P could not, of course, run the entire venture by himself and so he invited his life-long friend, Major Kenneth 'The Boy' McLaren to accompany him on the venture.



Each day was based on a different theme. 1st day: Preliminary, settling, Division into patrols; 2nd day: Campaigning, Camp resourcefulness etc; 3rd day: Observation; 4th day: Woodcraft; 5th day: Chivalry; 6th day: Saving a life; 7th : Patriotism; 8th day: sports and games; 9th day: Going home.

All the boys arrived on 30 July. They were divided into 4 patrols with one senior boy in each patrol being the patrol leader. B. P. has taken care to mix public school boys with town boys and separated the brothers. Each patrol leader was given full responsibility for the behavior of his patrol at all times. One patrol had six members while the other three patrols consisted of five members.
