



SDG 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth: To promote inclusive and

sustainable economic growth, employment and decent work for all.

Why?

Sustained and inclusive economic growth can drive progress, create decent jobs for all and improve living standards.

While real GDP per capita and labour productivity have increased globally, 731 million people remain below the US\$1.90 poverty line.

I have a job. Why does this matter to me?

How many people are unemployed?

The global unemployment rate has finally recovered ments from the global financial crisis of 2009. In 2018, it stood at 5 per cent— matching the precrisis level. However, large lead to unrest and disrupt disparities exist across repeace if it is left unadgions and age groups. In 2018, the unemployment rates in Northern Africa and Western Asia and Latin America and the Caribbean were over 2.5 times higher than those in Central and Southern Asia.

Are jobs enough?

Having a job does not guarantee á decent living. In fact, 8 per cent of employed workers and their families world- wide lived poverty in extreme 2018.

addition to creating jobs, we also need to imconditions for prove more than 700 mil- lion women and men who working, but not

earning enough themselves and their families out of poverty.

In addition, women and girls must enjoy equal ac-cess to equal opportunities with men and boys for employment.

Society as a whole benefits when more people are being productive and contributing to their country's growth. Proemployment ductive and are key ele-"decent work"

to achieving fair globalization and poverty reduction. In addition, unemployment dressed.

What does "decent work" mean?

Decent work means opportunities for every- one to get work that is productive and delivers a fair income, security in the workplace and social protection for families, better prospects for per-sonal development and social integration.

It is also important that all women and men are given equal opportunities in the workplace. A continued lack of decent work opportunities, insufficient investments and "Vocal For Our Local" under-consumption lead to an erosion of the basic social contract underlying democratic societies: that all must share in progress.

What can we do to fix these issues?

Providing youth the best op-portunity to transition to a decent job calls for investing in education and training of the highest possible quality, pro- viding youth with skills that match labour market

demands, giving them access to social protection and basic services regard-less of their contract type, as well as leveling the playing field so that all aspiring youth can attain productive employment regardless of their gender, income level or socioeconomic background.

Governments can work to build dynamic, sustainable, innovative and people- ceneconomies, promoting youth employment and women's economic empowerment, in particular, and decent work for all. Local authorities and communities can renew and plan their cities and human settlements so as to foster community cohesion and personal security and to stimulate innovation and employment.
